







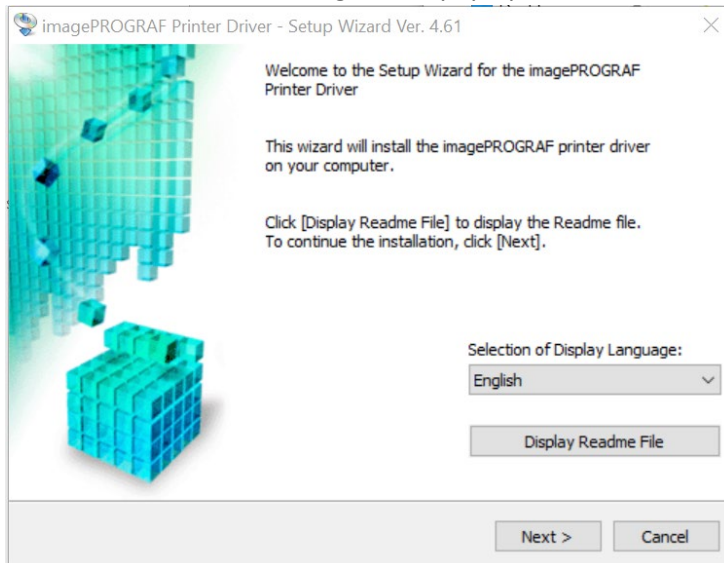


Loading the printer driver for Poster Artist Lite

1. You should have received a compressed zip file labeled “File Driver”
2. Inside this folder it should look like this:

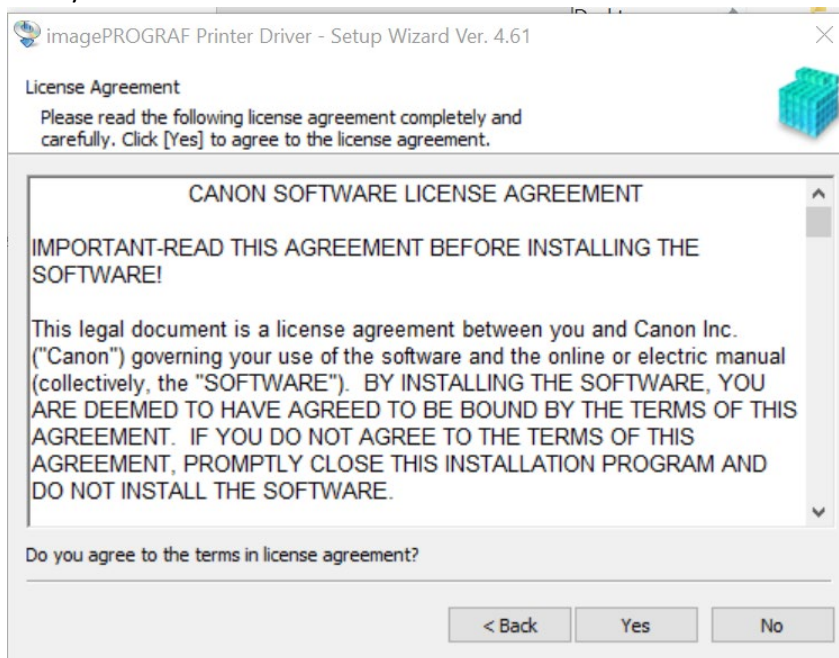

3. Double click the “Setup” application file.
4. You should see the following screen pop up.

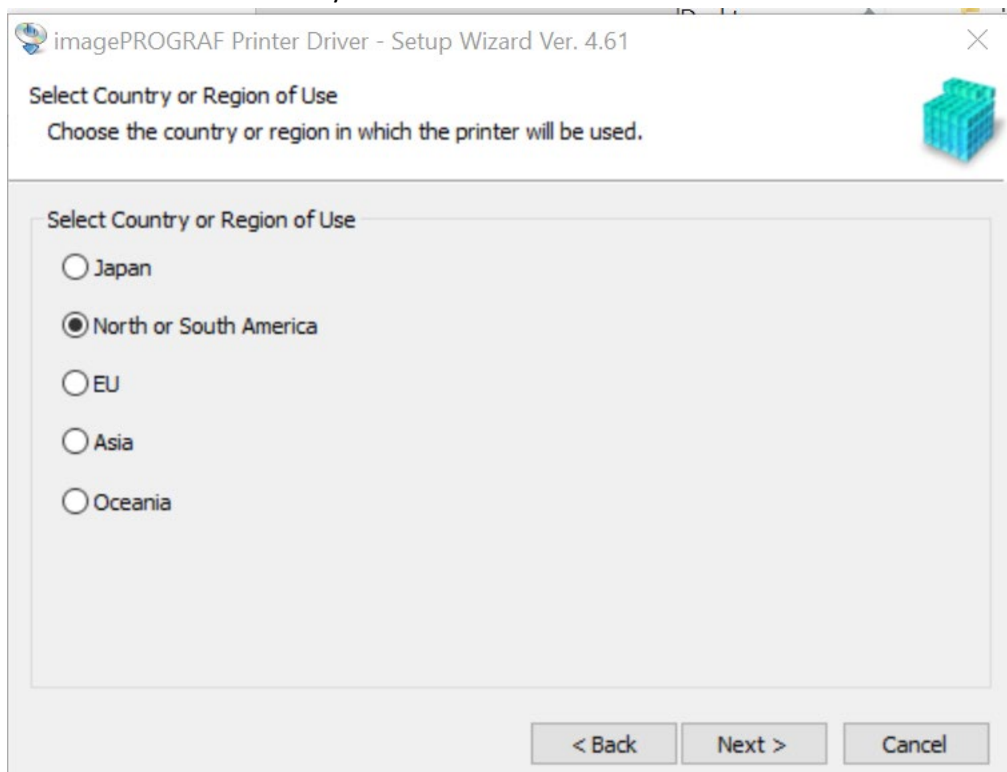


5. Make sure the language is set to English and click “Next”.

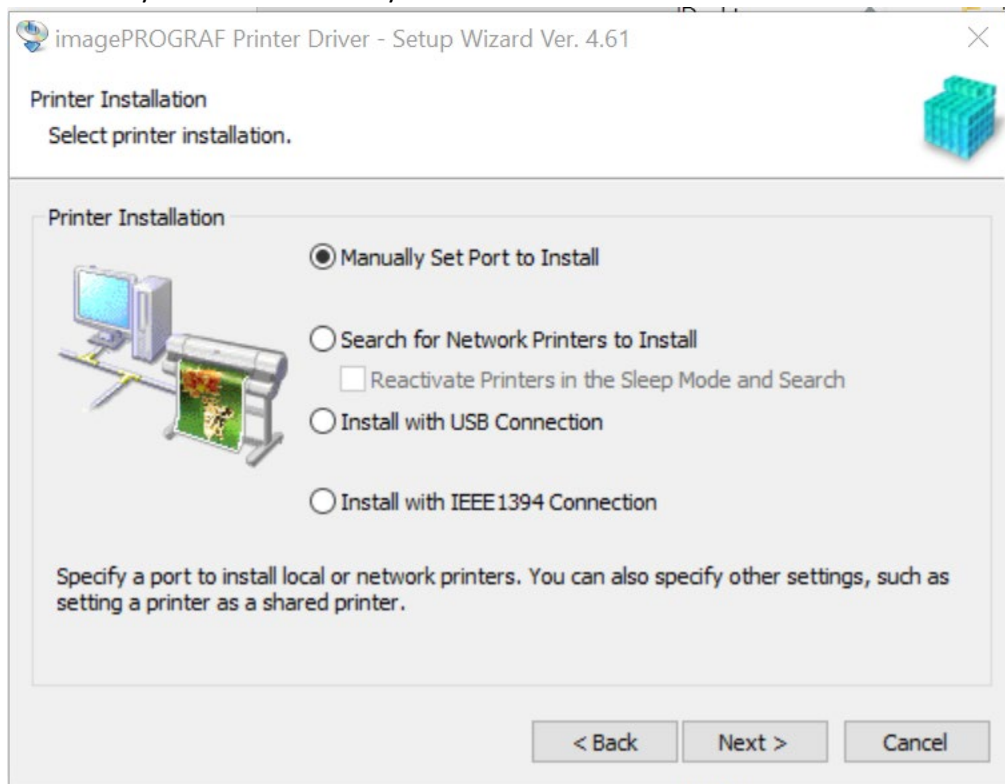
6. Now you will see this window.



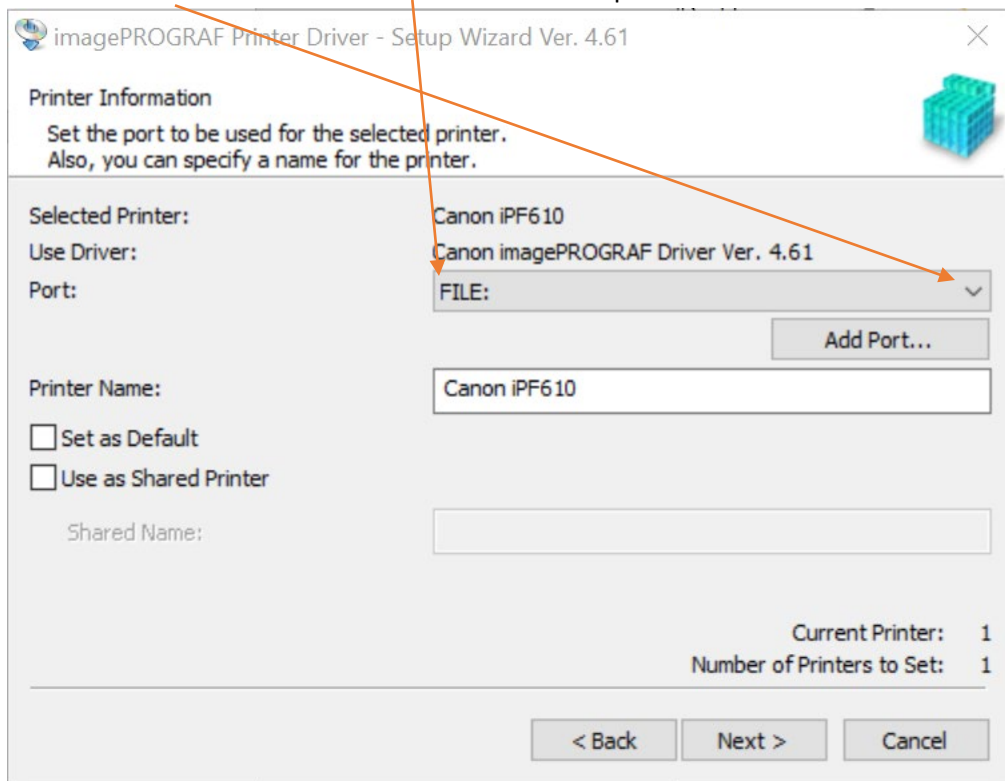
7. Click "Yes" to continue.

9. Make sure you select “Manually Set Port to Install” on this screen and click “Next”.



10. Click the down arrow to select “FILE:” from the drop down menu.



11. Now just click next and accept any of the other screens that appear to complete this install.
12. You will now be able to proceed with loading the PosterArtist Lite program.
